



The intention to set up the Mountain Wilderness Spain section within Mountain Wilderness International has been made public. The initiative arises from the current Ayllón-Guadarrama-Gredos section. They are comrades whom we know and who have been militant for years for the preservation of the mountains.

We welcome the initiative in the terms it is raised, with the respect shown by the existence of Mountain Wilderness Catalunya, a section created more than 30 years ago and which has a recognized background and trajectory in defense of the mountains. We express our unequivocal will to continue maintaining the Catalan section in the current terms, with the commitments and principles that we have always maintained. From the proximity and direct knowledge of the territory we believe that we can carry out more effectively the tasks of custody and protection of the mountains.

We will also be collaborating, as we have done until now, with all other sections of Mountain Wilderness International to achieve the principles of the association.

We hope that the initiative of Mountain Wilderness Spain can respond to large mountainous territories of the Iberian Peninsula where there was no option to work for its preservation from the current section.

We will continue to work, as before, in the mountains of Catalonia, its vicinity or around the world in collaboration with other sections or any person or entity seeking similar objectives in defense of the preservation and quality of mountain areas, as well as for a full mountain experience, which from responsibility becomes a source of freedom and creativity in direct contact with nature and the outdoors.
